Indigenous peoples and their cultures also influence Carol’s songwriting resulting in her being recognized by the Native American Music Association and Spirit Wind Records. Her songs have been included in films and she has won music credits from Europe to the U.S. Her songs are played by DJs throughout North America, Europe, Australia, and New Zealand.

REACTIONS: Fans remark on Carol’s clear, emotion-filled vocals and vocal strength and range. She reminds them of artists such as Emmylou Harris, Suzy Bogguss, Dolores O’Riordan, Sheryl Crow, and Natalie Merchant. Whether originals or covers, Carol’s song selections go over well.

PERFORMANCES: Carol accompanies herself on acoustic guitar, sometimes with other musicians, and performs a broad repertoire of songs for a variety of venues, such as music and folk festivals, house concerts, faith communities, restaurants and clubs, libraries, and museums and she has appeared on the Earnest Tubb Midnight Jamboree in Nashville!
